No. GG/28/2009/MKM/102007/267(PT-VI)/E-1: - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Assistant Director of Prohibition and Excise, Class II, in the General State Service, under the Directorate of Prohibition and Excise, Gujarat State namely:-

1 These rules may be called the Assistant Director of Prohibition and Excise, Class II, Recruitment Rules, 2010.

2 Appointment to the post of Assistant Director of Prohibition and Excise, Class II, in the Prohibition and Excise Department shall be made either,-

(a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-

(i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Office Superintendent, Class-III or Accountant Class-III, in the subordinate service of the Prohibition and Excise, Department, Gujarat State; and

(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience as specified in sub clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than 31 years of age;

(b) possess a second class degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or deemed to be as University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;

(c) possess three years administrative experience on the post not below the Class III post in the Government.

Explanation:- For the purpose of this rule, administrative experience shall ordinarily means work experience on the post not below the rank of Office Superintendent, Class III or the post equivalent in the nature of pay-scale, duties and responsibilities, in the State Government or in local bodies or Government owned Board or Corporation or Government undertaking or in a company established by law in India or registered firm, and recognized as such by the Government;

(d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and

(e) possess the adequate knowledge of Gujarati and/or Hindi:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a person who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period,

(i) be required to undergo the pre-service training and to pass the post-training examination in accordance with the Gazetted Officers' Pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.;

(ii) be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

6. The selected candidate shall require to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf.

7. The candidate appointed either by promotion or by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government in that behalf.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government in that behalf.
